Because there are some situations where relocating the animal is the only cost effective solution, we do offer wildlife relocation, but prefer to provide more lasting, long term solutions. The Wildlife Whisperer, Inc. wildlife management methods typically include repairs, exclusion and one way spring loaded doors to evict wildlife. These methods allow us to be certain that the babies and mothers stay together as a family unit. Being able to choose from a variety of relocation sites allows the animals we must relocate with a better chance of survival and also allows us to be certain that an area does not become overpopulated. This program has been instituted to aid The Wildlife Whisperer and wildlife rehabilitators in locating suitable sites for the release of wild animals.
